MBA Career Track

The Career Track for MBA/MPS students includes 2 marketing, entrepreneurship, finance or supply chain courses, or 2 UA graduate courses as approved by the Associate Dean for Research and Graduate Programs, Dynamics of Public Service or equivalent and Capstone.

Credit Hours Shared

Twelve hours will be transferred to the MBA degree from the MPS degree including: International Service Project, Practicum II, Dynamics of Social Change or equivalent and Capstone.

Eleven hours will be transferred to the MPS degree from the MBA degree including 9 hours of electives taken from Spring 1, Fall 2 and/or Spring 2 coursework; and 2 hours taken from Professional Development sequence to substitute for the Seminar in Professionalism in Public Service.

Graduation

Students may walk at the Walton Graduation Ceremony during Spring 3. Students will not graduate from either the MBA nor the MPS program until all requirements for both programs have been fulfilled, including MPS Capstone.
